## Whip up bubble wands with colorful wire and large-hole beads

Make simple wands by wrapping wire around a round object like a highlighting marker, a bottle of correction fluid, or a lipstick tube. Then grab some soapy liquid and let the bubbles fly!


## you'll need

-6-10 7-20 mm large-hole beads (\$1)

- 5-8 6 or $8^{\circ}$ seed beads*
- 16 in. ( 41 cm ) 18-gauge colored wire (Fire Mountain Gems and Beads, 800.355.2137,
firemountaingems.com, \$1)
- chainnose and roundnose pliers
- diagonal wire cutters
*These items cost less than \$1.


3Using a round object with a different diameter than the first one, make a wrapped loop. If you have trouble keeping the round shape as you complete the wraps, use your fingers to make the wraps with the round object still in the loop.
