



Star Ring Toss

what you need

- Wooden star coat hanger pegs, two
- Acrylic paints: yellow, blue, lt. blue, gold
- Pepperell Stretch Magic Beading Cord, 12" length (for each ring)
- Plastic beads, in assorted colors and sizes

the basic stuff

tape, scissors, ruler, paintbrush, newspaper (to cover work surface)

how to make it

- 1 On covered work surface, paint wooden pegs yellow. Let dry. Paint star designs blue and lt. blue. Let dry. Add gold highlights.
- 2 For each ring, measure and cut 12" length of beading cord. Knot one end of cord. Thread beads onto cord in desired pattern. Knot other end. Wrap beaded cord into circle.
- 3 To play, position wooden pegs on floor about eight feet apart. Have players stand and toss rings onto pegs.
